

- 4. Enter your new password paying attention to the rules for creating a strong one




Use Google Meet for connecting with your classmates and instructors either one-on-one or in groups using both chat and video. You can also share your computer screen during sessions.

- 4. Find your courses under the "my Courses" tab sorted by semester






